BIHERIT Project plans to publish papers and presentations from workshops (Banja Luka, 27.2.2014 and Tuzla 8.5.2014, Sarajevo, 2.6.2014) and Regional conference (Sarajevo, 3.6.2014). Project board nominated two editors: Ivana Pandžić and Predrag Novaković. We are taking this opportunity to invite all the speakers to send us their paper for publications. The publication will be published in the first stage as a pdf monograph available on the project web site, and later also in hardcopy as well.

Here are guidelines for the authors:

1. Texts will be published in the original languages of the presentations (1600 - 2200 words + references). Font should be Calibri size 11 for text. Manuscript should be prepared in such a form that it must include the title, a Summary including keywords, Introduction, Discussion, Conclusion, and References.
2. **Paper Title** (Calibri, 12 pts, Bold, Centered, the Initial Letter of Each Major Word should be Capitalized)

Author(s) (First name Last name - Calibri, 11 pts, Normal, Centered- The first name should be written with first letter in capital and the last name should be written all letters are capital)

Authors' institutions (Calibri, 11 pts, Normal, Centered)

3. **Short summary in English (300 words)**
4. Figures (photos, drawings, tables...) 5 - 10 (300 dpi resolution, color or black and white). Each figure, chart and table should be sent in original file (excel or other) in order to give opportunity for editing if necessary. Each figure and table have to have number and title e.g. Fig. (Tab.)1. Archeology in
5. All figures must be quoted (if they are not originally made for the presentations)
6. References should be written in Times New Roman, 10pt at single line spacing. First line of the reference should be at the beginning of paragraph and following lines must be drawn in of 0.5 cm.

Please ensure that every reference cited in the text is also present in the reference list. The system of "author and year" should be used for references in the manuscript except special cases. If there is more than one reference, then the references should be given in chronological order with separation of semi colon.

References in the text must be cited in the base of author and year, i.e.: Acar (1982), Metcalfe et al. (1984) at the beginning of the sentence or (Acar, 1982; Lodos and Boulard, 1987) at the end of the sentence, and except special case occurs.

References should be listed in alphabetical order of author's name and year. First letter of each word for the titles of the books and book chapters should be in capital. Publishing number for Institutional publishing or publisher's name and address should be given.

References from different sources should be typed according to following examples:
